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Band Handbook

Classroom Rules

*All school rules apply in this classroom

1. Respect the Class: Be seated with instrument together and music ready 2 minutes after bell rings and bring all required materials EVERY day.
2. Respect the Equipment: Protect your instruments from damage, clean your instruments, put books and tuners away, and do not touch percussion instruments without permission.
3. Respect Each Other: Every individual is important to making our group successful, so adhere to the Golden Rule- Treat others as you wish to be treated.

Required Class Materials

The following are required for class EVERY day. They should always be at the student's seat (not in cases or in hallway). Not having these items will result in a deduction of participation points.

1. Pencil (not a pen)

8. Instrument Specific Equipment
 - a. Woodwinds: Extra Reed and Cork Grease
 - b. Brass: Valve/Slide Oil
 - c. Percussion: Drumsticks, Yarn Mallets, Xylophone Mallets

Instrument Storage

There are places for students to store instruments in the band room. Everything is to be kept on a shelf. Stuff on the floor may be thrown away. If a student wishes to lock their instrument in the caged

storage spot, he/she must provide the lock. *The band program and Northridge Middle School are not responsible for lost items as everyone is given the chance to lock up their instrument.*

Facebook: NMS Band Geeks- The Facebook page is the easiest way to keep in communication with you. It is strongly encouraged all parents AND students with Facebook pages join this group.

Instagram: nmsbandgeeks- Pictures, pictures, pictures. Please do not send messages to this account. It is not checked frequently enough for communication.

Google Classroom- Every handout sent home and every homework assignment will be available for download on Google Classroom. If you lose a copy, this is a great place to find them. Recordings of performances will also be uploaded to this site.

Grading Procedures

Class Participation- Each week, students will receive 50 points for participating properly in class. If a student is tardy to class 5 points will be deducted. For playing with improper technique, being disruptive, or missing some required class material 10 points will be deducted.

Performance- Performances are the culminating events that show parents what has been accomplished in class. Students with an excused absence must complete an alternate assignment to receive credit for the performance. If a student does not show up and is not excused, his/her grade will be deducted two letter grades. *If a student misses two performances, he/she will no longer be allowed to participate in band class.*

Practice Reports- Students are rewarded for showing the instructors they are trying to improve. These are due every Friday and are worth 50 points. They will be accepted late but for only half credit. 100 minutes of practice are required weekly. We have no benchwarmers during concerts. EVERYONE is important to helping the band sound great.

FAILURE TO TURN IN PRACTICE REPORTS MAY RESULT IN ONE'S REMOVAL FROM BAND CLASS

Quizzes/Tests- Both written and performance quizzes/tests will be given. The number of points will be determined by the tests difficulty.

Homework- Wait, homework in Band Class? Yes, it is a class like every other, so students will be expected to turn in homework. Late assignments may lose up to 10% of points per day.

Extra Credit

There are a few extra credit opportunities listed below. If students have ideas for others, they can certainly be discussed with the instructor.

1. *See a Musical Show-* Go to a concert (musical symphony, band, choir, jazz band) and write a one page reaction about your experience there.
2. *Perform Outside of Class-* If you perform at all outside of class, bring a program from your performance or have the person in charge sign a note documenting your performance. If you can obtain a recording, Mr. Cone would love to hear it!
3. *Practice Extra-* The easiest and best way to gain extra points. All one has to do is practice 5 or more days in a week. It's as easy as blinking or making weapons-grade plutonium.
